CBM's Proposed Caledon Quarry

Introductory Meeting

Background

CBM Aggregates (CBM) is exploring the feasibility of developing a quarry in the vicinity of Charleston Sideroad and Main Street/Regional Road 136 in the Town of Caledon.

The lands in this area are identified as High Priority Aggregate Resource (Bedrock) Lands on the CHPMARA (Caledon High Priority Mineral Aggregate Resource Area) Prioritization Plan (Schedule L in the Town of Caledon's Official Plan). This reflects the fact that the bedrock in this area is considered a significant, high-quality resource in the province.

CBM initiated technical studies in February 2020 as part of the information gathering that we will be completing over the next two years to assist in determining the feasibility of future extraction, and to support the required applications that may be filed for municipal and provincial approvals under the *Planning Act* and the *Aggregate Resources Act*.
