



CBM Aggregates' Proposed Caledon Quarry – Update on Drilling & Technical Studies

As you were informed in an introductory letter sent to you in November 2019 and a follow-up notice sent to you in March 2020, CBM Aggregates (CBM) is exploring the opportunity and feasibility of developing a quarry in the vicinity of Charleston Sideroad and Main Street/Regional Road 136.

After having paused the drilling program in June 2020, we wanted to inform you that CBM will be restarting drilling activities in the area, including groundwater monitoring well installations, during the week of October 19, 2020, as part of the technical studies that we will be completing over the coming years for this project. The drilling and monitoring well installation will continue for the next couple of months under the supervision of Golder Associates Ltd., our consultants on the project. You may notice people walking in the surrounding fields and you may hear drilling activity in the area during this time.

Please note that these wells are being installed to support the on-going technical studies needed to understand the feasibility of the project. If deemed to be feasible, the drilling and groundwater monitoring results will also be used to support future planning and licence applications.

We are updating you on this work as part of our ongoing commitment to keep the community informed about the project.

CBM is still planning to hold an initial public information session to provide an opportunity for neighbours to ask questions and receive more information about the potential licence application. Due to the restrictions associated with COVID-19 on public gatherings, we had to cancel our meeting planned in March 2020 but are currently exploring alternative methods including holding an initial public information session through a virtual format. We will be distributing invitations closer to the date of the event once we have worked out the details.
